WOULD YOU LIKE (TO) ...? SHALL WE ...? WHY DON'T WE ...?

We use would you like (to) ... in order to make offers. (Would you like (to) ... [ister misin] yapısını birisine teklifte bulunmak için kullanırız.)

We also use shall we ...? and why don't we ...? for making an offer. Teklifte bulunmak için shall we ...? [... yapalım mı?] ve why don't we ...? [... niçin yapmıyoruz?] ifadelerini de kullanırız.

We use the phrases below for accepting or refusing an offer. (Aşağıdaki ifadeleri teklifi kabul ederken veya reddederken kullanırız.)

accepting (kabul etme)

Yes, please.
That's nice of you.
All right. Thanks.
That's a good idea.
Sounds great.
Yes, I'd like to.

Yes, I'd love to.

refusing (reddetme)

No, thanks.
No, but thanks for your offer
I'm really full. Thanks.
I'm sorry, I can't. I feel tired.
I'd like to, but I can't. I'm very busy.
I'd love to, but I have some work to do.

THE PRESENT SIMPLE

We use the Present Simple to talk about daily routines, habits, likes and dislikes.

Günlük işlerden, davranışlardan, hoşlanılan ve hoşlanılmayan şeylerden bahsetmek için The Present Simple - Geniş Zaman - kullanırız.)

Affirmative Form (Olumlu Yapı)

I / you / we / they listen to music a lot.

He / She / It listens to music a lot.

Negative Form (Olumsuz Yapı)

I / you / we / they don't listen to music a lot.

He / She / It doesn't listen to music a lot.

Question Form (Soru Yapısı)

Do I / you / we / they listen to music a lot?

Does he / she / it listen to music a lot?

Short Answers (Kısa Cevaplar)

No, I / you / we / they don't.

Yes, he / she / it does.

FIRST, SECOND, FINALLY

We call first*, second*, third*, also*, then*, next*, after that* and finally* as sequencing words. We use these sequencing words to describe a series of events or a process in a time order. (First*, second*, third*, also*, then*, next*, after that* ve finally* ifadelerini sıralama kelimeleri olarak adlandırmaktayız. Bir zaman aralığına göre, bir dizi olayı veya aşamayı tarif etmek için bu sıralama kelimelerini kullanırız.

THE FUTURE TENSE - WILL

We use the Future Tense - Will to talk about the decisions we take at the time of speaking. These decisions about the future are spontaneous, but not planned.

(Gelecek Zaman ile ilgili olan will yapısını konuşma anında verdiğimiz kararları ifade etmek için kullanırız. Gelecek ile ilgili bu kararlar kendiliğinden meydana gelir, planlı değildirler.)

Affirmative Form (Olumlu Yapı)

I / you / we / they will answer the phone.

He / She / It will answer the phone.

Negative Form (Olumsuz Yapı)

I / you / we / they won't answer the phone.

He / She / It won't answer the phone.

Question Form (Soru Yapısı)

Will I / you / we / they answer the phone?

Will he / she / it they answer the phone?

Short Answers (Kısa Cevaplar)

No, I / you / we / they won't.

Yes, he / she / it won't.
